Binders, Folders, and Paper:

- 1 sturdy plastic or cardboard 1.5-inch binder (no zipper binders please!)
- 2 plastic folders with pockets – no prongs
- 6 paper duotangs (various colours)
- 3 packages of loose-leaf
- 1 package of dividers
- 3 pads of Post-It Notes in various colours (3x3 size is best)

Writing Utensils:

- A minimum of 40 pencils (wooden are preferred) – Please pre-sharpen 10 pencils at home
- 3 white erasers
- 2 fine tip black Sharpies
- 2 blue pens
- 2 black pens
- A few highlighters of various colours (skinny highlighters are preferred)
- A small pencil case
- 1 covered pencil sharpener
- 1 package of dry erase markers and a dry eraser

Supplies:

- 1 package of coloured pencils
- 1 package of crayons
- 1 package of fat tipped markers
- 1 package of skinny tipped markers
- 3 glue sticks
- 2 bottles of liquid white glue
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 30 cm ruler
- 1 protractor
- 1 scientific calculator

Other:

- 1 box of Kleenex
- 5 large unused Ziploc Bags
- 5 small unused Ziploc Bags
- 1 pair of earbuds or headphones that will either stay with you at school or in your bookbag but should not be ones that you bring back and forth (can be inexpensive)
- Indoor sneakers to stay at school
- Water bottle

A Few Things to Note:

- Please feel free to use any school supplies from previous years that are still in good condition.

- Brand names do not matter! Over the next few weeks many stores will have these items on sale.
- Due to COVID-19 restrictions and public health protocols announced by the province, students will not have access to lockers. The majority of student school supplies will be stored in the classroom for individual use. Some supplies may be sent home for storage and requested when needed.
- With the enhanced protocols, sharing of supplies or bulk supplies housed in the classroom will not be possible this year. It is important for students to have their own individual school supplies to minimize touch and increase distancing.
